KANSAS CITY CHIEFS

- **CHIEFS** advanced to 6th-straight AFC Champ. Game, 2nd-longest streak in NFL history. Seeking 4th SB appearance in past 5 years.
- **ANDY REID** has 24 career playoff wins, 2nd-most ever by HC. Appearing in 11th Champ. Game as HC, surpassing HOFer Tom Landry (10) for 2nd-most ever by HC. With win, can become 4th HC ever to appear in 5 SBs.
- **QB PATRICK MAHOMES** completed 17 of 23 atts. (73.9 pct.) for 215 yards & 2 TDs vs. 0 INTs with 131.6 rating in AFC-Div., 5th-straight playoff game with TD pass & 0 INTs. Is 13-3 in 16 career playoff starts & can become 6th QB all-time with 14+ career playoff wins. Is 3-1 with 1,479 pass yards (369.8 per game) & 13 TDs (12 pass, 1 rush) vs. 2 INTs & 119.1 rating in 4 career starts vs. Bal., with 325+ pass yards, 2+ TD passes & 90+ rating in each game.
- **RB ISIAH PACHECO** led team with 111 scrimmage yards (97 rush, 14 rec.) & had rush TD in AFC-Div., 6th-straight game overall with TD. Has 75+ scrimmage yards in each of 5 career playoff games, with rush TD in each of past 3.
- **TE TRAVIS KELCE** had 5 catches for 75 yards & 2 TDs in AFC-Div., 12th-straight playoff game with 5+ catches & 11th-straight playoff game with 50+ rec. yards, both 2nd-longest streaks in NFL history. Needs 7 catches to surpass HOFer Jerry Rice (151) for most postseason receptions ever. Has 6+ catches & 70+ rec. yards in each of 5 career games vs. Bal, incl. 109 rec. yards & rec. TD in last meeting.
- **WR RASHEE RICE** (rookie) has 5+ catches & 50+ rec. yards in 7 of past 8. Has 304 rec. yards (101.3 per game) in his past 3 overall.
- **WR MARQUEZ VALDES-SCANTLING** had 62 rec. yards in AFC-Div. Had 5 catches for 98 yards & TD in only career game vs. Bal. (12/19/21 w/ GB).
- **DT CHRIS JONES** had 1st-career playoff FF & PD in AFC-Div. Has 0.5+ sacks in 4 of past 5 overall. Has 2 sacks & 2 FFs in 2 career games at Bal. Had 10.5 sacks in 2023 reg. season.
- **DE GEORGE KARLAFTIS** aims for 4th in row with TFL. Has 1.5+ sacks in 2 of past 3. Had career-best 10.5 sacks in 2023.
- **LB NICK BOLTON** led team with 13 sacks in AFC-Div., 3rd-straight game with 10+ tackles. Had 9 tackles & TFL in last meeting.
- **CB L'JARIUS SNEED** had 5 tackles in AFC-Div. Has 8 PD in his past 6 overall. Had career-high 14 PD in 2023.
- **CB CHAMARRI CONNER** had career-high 10 tackles & FF in AFC-Div.

BALTIMORE RAVENS

- **RAVENS** are hosting AFC Champ. Game for 1st time ever. Can advance to 3rd SB in franchise history (XXXV & XLVII). Led NFL in rushing offense in 2023 (156.5 yards per game).
- **JOHN HARBAUGH** led Baltimore to SB XLVII title in 2012.
- **QB LAMAR JACKSON** totaled 252 yards (152 pass, 100 rush) & 4 TDs (2 pass, 2 rush) vs. 0 INTs with 121.8 rating in AFC-Div., becoming 2nd player ever with 100+ rush yards, 2+ TD passes & 2+ rush TDs in a playoff game (Colin Kaepernick on 1/12/13). Has 100+ rush yards in 3 of 5 career playoff starts, most by QB in NFL history. Had career-high 3,678 pass yards in 2023 & led QBs with 821 rush yards, becoming 2nd player ever with 3,500+ pass yards & 800+ rush yards in a season, joining Kyler Murray (2020). Totalled 346 yards (239 pass, 107 rush) & 3 TDs (2 rush, 1 pass) in last meeting vs.KC.
- **RB GUS EDWARDS** set career highs in rush yards (810) & rush TDs (13) in 2023, 2nd-most rush TDs in a season in franchise history.
- **RB JUSTICE HILL** had 77 scrimmage yards (66 rush, 11 rec.) in AFC-Div.
- **TE MARK ANDREWS** can make 1st appearance since Week 11. Had 6 rec. TDs in 2023 & is 1 of 2 TEs (Travis Kelce) with 5+ rec. TDs in each of past 5 seasons.
- **TE ISAIAH LIKELY** had TD catch in AFC-Div. & has rec. TD in 5 of past 6 overall, incl. each of past 4 at home.
- **WR ZAY FLOWERS** ranked 4th among rookies with 77 catches & 5th with 858 rec. yards, both most-ever by Ravens rookie.
- **WR NELSON AGHOLOR** had TD catch in AFC-Div. Has TD catch in each of 3 career games vs. KC.
- **DT JUSTIN MADUBUIKE** had TFL in AFC-Div. Was selected to 1st-career Pro Bowl after leading team with 13 sacks in 2023, most by Bal. player since 2014.
- **LB ROQUAN SMITH** led team with 7 tackles & 2 TFL in AFC-Div., 8th-straight game overall with 7+ tackles. Ranked 6th in NFL with 158 tackles in 2023, 3rd-straight season with 150+ tackles
- **LB PATRICK QUEEN** aims for his 5th in row with 5+ tackles. Totalled career-best 133 tackles this season.
- **LB JADEVEON CLOWNEY** tied career high with 9.5 sacks in 2023. Has TFL in each of 4 career games vs. KC.
- **S KYLE HAMILTON** led team with career-high 13 PD in 2023.
- **S GENO STONE** ranked 2nd in NFL with 7 INTs in 2023.

DETROIT LIONS

- **DETROIT** makes 2nd NFC-C appearance in franchise history (1991). Tied franchise record with 12 reg. season wins & clinched 1st division title since 1993. Became 2nd team ever (2013 Broncos) with 4+ players (4) each with 10+ scrimmage TDs in same season.
- **QB JARED GOFF** aims for his 3rd in row in 2023 playoffs with 275+ pass yards & 100+ rating. Aims for his 5th playoff game in row with TD pass & 0 INTs. Ranked 2nd in pass yards (4,575) & 4th in TD passes (30) in 2023 reg. season. Passed for 338 yards & 3 TDs in last reg. season meeting (9/12/21). Has 2+ TD passes in each of his 4 career starts at SF.
- **RB DAVID MONTGOMERY** has 115 scrimmage yards & rush TD in 2023 playoffs. Had 1,132 scrimmage yards (1,015 rush, 117 rec.) & career-high 13 rush TDs in 2023, his 5th-straight 1,000-yard season.
- **RB JAHMYR GIBBS** had 114 scrimmage yards (74 rush, 40 rec.) & rush TD in NFC-Div. vs. TB. Can become 1st rookie with rush TD in each of 1st 3 playoff games since 2019 (Sony Michel). Ranked 1st among rookies in rush TDs (10), tied-1st in scrimmage TDs (11) & 3rd in scrimmage yards (1,261). Montgomery & Gibbs became 1st pair of teammates in NFL history each with 1,000+ scrimmage yards & 10+ rush TDs in same season.
- **WR AMON-RA ST. BROWN** had 8 catches for 77 yards & 1st-career postseason TD last week. Can become 1st player with 7+ catches in each of 1st 3 career playoff games since 2018 (Michael Thomas). Ranked tied-2nd in NFL with career-high 119 catches, 3rd with career-high 1,515 rec. yards & had career-high 10 rec. TDs in 2023.
- **TE SAM LAPORTA** had 9 catches last week, most by rookie TE in playoff game all-time. Set NFL rookie TE record in receptions (86), had 4th-most rec. yards (889) by rookie TE all-time & became 3rd rookie TE ever with 10+ rec. TDs (10). Gibbs & LaPorta became 1st pair of rookie teammates each with 10+ TDs.
- **DL AIDAN HUTCHINSON** aims for his 3rd in row in playoffs & 5th in row overall with sack. Had career highs in sacks (11.5) & TFL (14), FFs (3) & PD (7) in 2023.
- **LB ALEX ANZALONE** has 5+ tackles in 17 of 18 games this season, incl. playoffs. Had career-high 129 tackles in 2023.
- **DB BRIAN BRANCH** had 1st-career playoff sack last week.
- **DB C.J. GARDNER-JOHNSON** had 1st-career playoff INT in NFC-Div.
- **S IFEATU MELIFONWU** had 1.5 sacks last week.
